

Granting a mandate in Suomi.fi e-Authorizations for the NIS2 operator list e-service

1 What is the mandate needed for?

Suomi.fi e-Identification is used for identification in the e-service for registering in the NIS2 operator list. Identification is carried out using, for example, online banking codes or a mobile certificate.

It is possible to use the service when a company has granted the person a Suomi.fi e-Authorization to act on behalf of the company in the e-service for operator data related to cyber security.

Suomi.fi e-Authorization is not required if the person acts on behalf of a company or organisation in which they have an official role entered in the Trade Register

- Managing director
- Substitute for the managing director
- Partner
- Holder of procuration authorised to sign alone for the company/organisation
- Self-employed business operator
- Liquidator

2 Description of the mandate

Suomi.fi e-Authorizations has one mandate type for the e-service for the NIS2 operator list:

- **Reporting details of cyber security operators**

This mandate allows the assignee to use all the features of the e-service related to the NIS2 operator list:

- Report the operator data referred to in section 41 of the Cyber Security Act
- Manage the reported data (submit notifications of change)
- Check the registered data.

Operators must notify changes to the reported information without delay. A change to the information referred to in section 41, sub-section 2 of the Cyber Security Act must be notified to the supervisory authority within two weeks from the date of the change.


3 Who can grant a mandate and how is it done?

A mandate may be granted by a person who has one of the official roles mentioned in paragraph 1 (e.g., managing director or holder of procuration) entered in the Trade Register for the company or organisation in question. The role information is checked in the Trade Register, the Business Information System, the Finnish Register of Associations and Suomi.fi e-Authorizations.

Do the following to grant a mandate for acting on behalf of a company:

1. Open the [Suomi.fi e-Authorizations home page](#) and identify yourself to log in to Suomi.fi e-Authorizations. Go to the section “Company’s mandates”.



2. Select the company you are acting on behalf of. Add the mandate “Reporting details of cyber security operators” to the person you are authorising. To add a mandate, you need the name and personal identity code of the person to whom the mandate is being granted. You can specify a period of validity for the mandate.
 3. You will receive an email notification when the mandate has been confirmed.
- ### 4 How has the use of the e-service for the NIS2 list of operators been restricted?

The e-service for the NIS2 list of operators is intended for essential and important operators within the scope of the Cyber Security Act:

- Operators manufacturing medicinal substances and medicines
- Entities involved in the research and development of medicines
- Blood establishments
- Pharmacies and operators supplying and providing medicines and medical devices as healthcare professionals
- Manufacturers of medical devices and in vitro medical devices for diagnostics
